“David Galea Wins MTV Design Competition”

## Fun, fresh and bright a winner

CAROLINE Springs' David Galea, 16, is the youngest winner of the Slurpee Tee - The Human Canvas design competition.

David's design *Stacked Sunnies* beat five other finalists and more than 400 T-shirt design entries from across the country.

He was successful thanks to online voting, which saw more than 27,000 people pick their favourite design.

David won a \$5000 prize, a week-long internship with the MTV creative department and got to see his design brought to life on a limited-edition T-shirt.

“Every minute of the Slurpee Tee competition has been fantastic for me,” he said.

“Seeing three of my designs exhibit in the top 26 alone was a big surprise.

“Then meeting the other finalists and seeing all of their designs was great.

“To win was just amazing.”

Slurpee brand manager Rebecca Mountstephen said David's design was fun, fresh and bright.
