YEAR 12 LITERATURE

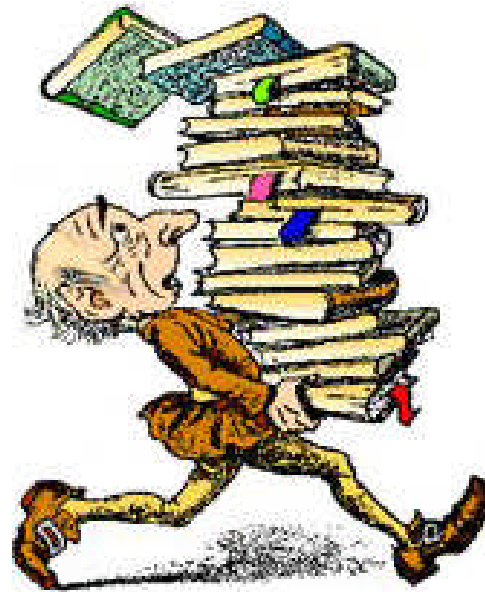
Guest Speaker Richard Sallis
